Garden Care

Plant Science

- 100 The part of a plant that absorbs water and nutrients from the soil
(What are roots?)
- 200 The process by which plants make their own food from air, water and sunlight
(What is photosynthesis?)
- 300 The process by which a seed takes in water and swells, and the embryo starts to grow
(What is germination?)
- 400 The process by which plants use colors and smells to attract insects and animals to produce the fruit of the plant
(What is pollination?)
- 500 Animal that helps break down nutrients in the soil
(What is a worm?)
